Hunting Guidelines

2021-2022

General Rules

- **Completion of 20 work hours are required to hunt all Wolf Creek properties.**
- Hunter orange must be worn except for archery deer hunting, turkey hunting and waterfowl hunting.
- No dog training on the Fayette property.
- Parking pass must be displayed in vehicle window when on Wolf Creek property to hunt.
- Hunters must sign in prior to hunting at all Wolf Creek properties.
- The Fayette property is open to ONLY archery deer and archery turkey hunting until the first Friday in November.
- Youth hunters must be accompanied at all times by an adult.
- The range is open from 11 AM to 1 PM daily. All hunting on the Teachout Road property is closed during range hours.
- Be aware of shooting time. No late walking in! It disrupts the other hunters who are settled in and hunting.
- Each hunter must sign a waiver.
- Respect others while hunting.

Youth, Veterans and Women's Hunt

- **You must sign up by 8:00 PM on the Tuesday before the hunt.**
- **It is required that you sign up your dog if you plan to bring one.**
- All hunters must be at the Club House on Teachout Road BEFORE 8:00 AM to attend the safety speech. **If you do not attend the safety speech you will not be allowed to hunt.**
- Youth hunters must have a valid hunting license and must have completed a hunter's safety course.
- An adult must accompany all Youth.
- Veterans must have a valid hunting license.
- Women must be age 17 or older and must have a valid hunting license.
- We will be banding birds.
- Hunts will be split into two groups if necessary, to keep the field from being too congested.
- Hunter orange is REQUIRED.

Deer Hunting

- Deer baiting at the Club House property on Teachout Road MUST be off the ground due to water fowl hunting regulations.
- No new permanent deer stands are allowed on any Wolf Creek property.
- No moving of any permanent deer stands on any Wolf Creek property, they must remain in their current and registered locations.
- You must have permission to use the deer stand or ground blind of another member.
- There are three club stands on the Fayette property, which are available for any member to use. Hunt pass is required. User is responsible for checking the safety of the stand.
- All members with stands must maintain them for safety reasons.
- It is expected that each deer stand/blind is presented in a way that least disturbs the natural environment. All excessive timber, cording, building material or other unnatural accumulation MUST be removed.
- **No work on stands after September 12, 2021.**

Pheasant Hunting

- **You must sign up by 8:00 PM on the Tuesday before the hunt.**
- All adult pheasant hunts will be at the Club House property on Teachout Road.
- You must have a pheasant hunting pass to hunt pheasants on **ALL** Wolf Creek properties.
- To receive one work hour for setting birds you must arrive by 6:30 AM and participate in setting birds.
- You **MUST** sign in when hunting on any Wolf Creek property.
- Youth of club members are welcome to participate in the Thanksgiving Day adult pheasant hunt. They must have completed the hunters safety course and have a hunting license.
- Hunts will be split into two groups if necessary, to keep the field from being too congested. Group 1 will pass up and back. Group 2 will pass up and back. Any hunter without two birds can finish the hunt as one group.

2021 Adult Hunt Dates:

November 6, 2021

November 25, 2021 (Thanksgiving Day)

December 11, 2021

December 26, 2021

Water Fowl

- Water Fowl hunting will be open all day on Tuesday and Thursday, on Saturday morning and Sunday afternoon during Water Fowl season. No hunting is allowed during range hours.
- **PLEASE STAY OFF THE NEIGHBORS PROPERTY!**
- Water Fowl hunting will be closed on Thanksgiving Day due to the adult pheasant hunt.
- You must be at the Club House one hour prior to shooting time to confer with other hunters.

Fees

- Land Pass \$20
- Pheasant Pass \$70.
- Release Day Pass \$30. You must have completed 20 work hours and have a land pass.
